Following Christ Will Cost You

Introduction

- □ 7.3B people on the earth today; Christianity (2.2B), Islam (1.6B), Hinduism (1B), Buddhism (0.5B), Judaism (0.01B) masses of <u>dedicated</u> followers
- Massive crowds followed Jesus during his ministry
- □ The majority in the crowds selfishly wanted something from Jesus
- □ His true disciples left everyone/everything to follow Jesus
- His true disciples trusted Jesus with their future
- I. The Priority of Christ (v. 25-26)
 - A. Love

No <u>created thing</u> or <u>person</u> is to have the highest priority for a believer's love (1Jn. 2:15-17; 1Tim. 6:10; Mt. 10:37; 22:37). <u>Self</u>-love or preservation must never have the highest priority for a believer. Christ alone warrants the highest priority for a believer's love – "If anyone comes to me".

B. Loyalty

No <u>created thing</u> or <u>person</u> is to have the highest priority for a believer's loyalty (Lk. 16:13). <u>Self</u>-loyalty must never have the highest priority for a believer.

Love & loyalty for Christ must have the highest priority for any believer.

- II. The Sacrifice for Christ (v. 27-33)
 - A. Sacrifice of self (v. 27)

Commitment to Christ must not have selfish stipulations. Commitment to Christ must not be contingent on personal pleasures, desires or even needs of life (Lk. 9:23-24).

B. Sacrifice of things (v. 28-33)

Commitment to Christ involves sacrificing everything in order to <u>finish</u> & <u>win</u> in this life (v. 28-32; Mt. 10:22; Rom. 8:37). A believer must be willing to lose all earthly possessions for Christ & the will of God (v. 33; Lk. 9:25).

The unconditional sacrifice of self & things is essential for a true believer!
