O God, Strengthen My Hands

Introduction and Review

- □ Nehemiah is obeying the will of God in an extremely difficult ministry rebuilding the wall of Jerusalem for God's glory.
- ☐ God has already given Nehemiah victory against several plots from opponents ridicule & threats of violence (4:1-23).
- ☐ God has also given victory over internal problems among the people of God pervasive financial problems (5:1-19). We saw the extraordinary benefits of ministry in the fear of God.
- □ Today we will see two new plots from opponents & two amazing ways that God protects & delivers believer in ministry for Him.
- I. Opposition by Worldly Deception (v. 1-9)
 - A. The deceptive offer (v. 1-2, 4-7)

 Opponents are interested in & informed about believers'
 progress in gospel ministry (v. 1). Opponents will use clever
 tactics of distraction, compromise & even physical danger to
 stop progress (v. 2). Past failures do not dissuade opponents
 from trying the same & new strategies (v. 4-7) repetition to
 weaken resistance (4 times), slander & gossip.
 - B. The wise response (v. 3, 8-9)

 Nehemiah knows that this ministry & work is in the will of
 God and therefore vitally important "a great work" (v. 3).

 It may seem insignificant to people observing, but not to
 God & those who trust Him. He refuses to be distracted or
 make compromises from his mission "I cannot come
 down". He simply denies the false accusations (without
 defending himself) & continues the work (v. 8; Ps. 26:1). He
 knows that deceptive opponents have deceptive plans (v. 9a).
 He also knows that that he needs God's help to remain
 faithful & strong prayer (v. 9b).

II. Opposition by Religious Deception (v. 10-14)

A. The deceptive offer (v. 10)

Some opponents to God's ministry are in the religious community – false leaders, members, etc. Christ, Paul & Peter warn believers about these pretenders. They pretend to be interested in the welfare of believers – health, finances,

- etc. which sounds godly & honorable. They make deceptive offers to help believers traps & snares. They are instruments & children of the devil (Jn. 8:41ff). The devil will do anything to stop a believer from doing the work God has called you to do any trick, lie, deception; use anyone not submissive to Christ.
- B. The wise response (v. 11-14)

 God gives believers discernment & wisdom regarding our opponents "I understood and saw..." (v. 12-13a-b; Ps. 119:98). Nehemiah discerned that this was ungodly counsel based on fear (not to trust God) & rebellion (not to obey God). God also gives wisdom to respond (v. 11). Opponents want to give believers a bad reputation (v. 13c) guilt & shame destroy ministries. Believers know we need divine help to deal with opponents prayer (v. 14; Rom. 12:19).

ILL: David had repeated, first- hand experience with deceptive people that continually sought to trap, ensnared & harm him. He also experienced God faithfulness & repeated deliverance (Ps. 31:1-4; 119:109-110; 140:4-8; 141:8-10).

APPL: The same is true of you and me. We face opposition daily if we are engaged in the will & work of the Lord. We have the same enemy as Nehemiah, David & every other saint. Clothing styles, modes of transportation & communication have changed, but the enemy is still the same. And his objective is to kill, steal & destroy. But Jesus Christ has given us abundant life, immutable promises, limitless resources & access to God Almighty to supply all our needs according to His riches in glory in Christ Jesus.
