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A WORD FROM OUR PASTOR

Why Do We Love?

"We love because He first loved us." 1 John 4:19 (ESV)

In this context, the Apostle John has already told us how we can know that God lives in us and that we live in Him – "by the Spirit" (3:24; 4:13). We have also been taught that God lives in those who confess that Jesus is the Son of God, and those who confess live in Him (4:15). John then addresses the knowing, believing and perfecting of the love of God in the believer (4:16-18). When a believer has a close and loving relationship with God, then there is no fear of the future and final judgment. The love of God and the fear of punishment from God are in opposition to each other, and therefore, should not co-exist in a believer. This loving relationship that gives eternal confidence then is precious to every believer.

Because the love of God is vital for this confidence, then it is extremely important that the believer understand the nature and source of this love. It is important that the believer understands why we even love at all – this is the basis of our eternal future. Therefore, John gives the reason that every believer loves God, "We love because He first loved us." God showed His love for us first by sending His Son as an atoning sacrifice for our sins (4:10). Those who are humble recipients and beneficiaries of God's love then love God in return.

Believers can never claim that our love for God was prior to His love for us or that our love for Him originated within ourselves. God always comes first in loving us and therefore, our love is actually a response to Him and His goodness to us. Our love is a copy of His love; He originates it and we follow His example. Our capacity or ability to love God (and our neighbor) is a result of God's love for us and in us.

Therefore my beloved brother or sister, do you see why it is so important to understand both the nature and source of the love that exists within us? Do you see why we must thank God that He has enabled us to love Him? Do you see why we must never take any credit for our capacity to love? We are a peculiar people who have been particularly blessed for this life and eternity. The love of God prepares us to live this life without fear of punishment. Thanks be to God who has revealed that, "We love because He first loved us."
